

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
AND
REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
REGARDING
THE REDESIGNATION OF
CONNECTICUT'S PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY SYSTEM
FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES
AND
CLIENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Public Act 16-66 requires Governor Malloy, no later than July 1, 2017, to designate a nonprofit entity as Connecticut's Protection and Advocacy (P&A) system, replacing the Office of Protection and Advocacy for Persons with Disabilities, which will be abolished by law on July 1, 2017.

On January 20, 2017, Governor Malloy issued a [Public Notice](#) of his intent to designate Disability Rights Connecticut (DRCT) to be Connecticut's Protection and Advocacy for Persons with Disabilities system and to operate Connecticut's Client Assistance Program.

The Office of Policy and Management (OPM) will be holding a public hearing regarding the Governor's intent to designate DRCT. The hearing will be held:
